- 16. As you look you will notice that one of the citations has a yellow triangle with an exclamation mark. This is telling us that there is information missing in the citation. To check this out, click on the yellow triangle.
- 17. The problem is that there is no issue number in the issue field.
- 18. To fix the issue, find the issue number and enter it in the field.
- 19. When you finish, click on "Save."
