What excites you most about your research?

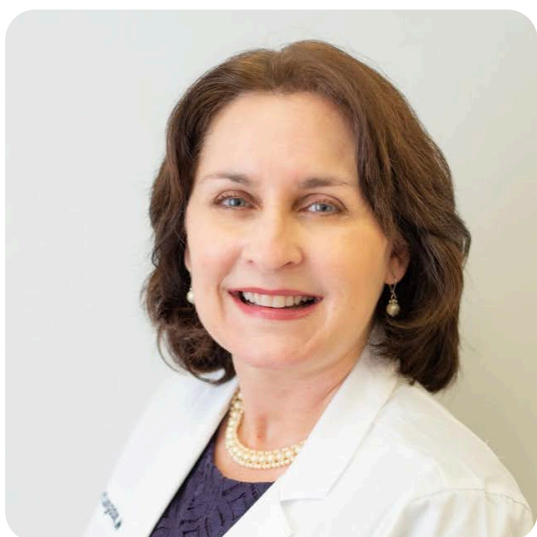
I am most excited for my book to shed light on healthcare disparities for children in rural areas.
